13, 1850 in Hamburg, Germany. He
was smuggled into the USA by his
Brother Henry. He arrived Sept. 5,
1864 on The Ship GERMANIA at the
age of 14.

Peter's Mother was a Sister to
Johannes Brahms's Father, who was a
performer in an Orchestra in a
leading Theatre in Hamburg, Germany.

Johannes Brahms, The Son was the
Great Musician who wrote and played
the Song "Brahms Lullaby."

Peter married Mary Emilyne Cooper in
the Summer of 1876, from Big Sandy,
Tennessee. They had 9 Children:
Christina, William, George, Edward,
Elbert, Clara, Luvenia, Arthur and
Velma.

Peter died December 3, 1923 and is
buried in Oak Grove Cemetery, off of
North 14th. Street, Paducah, Ky. on
his Son Arthur Schoening's lot.

Pleasant Ridge Cemetery, Big Sandy,
