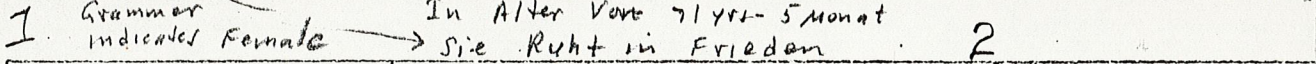

in 1875 boarded w/Mrs. Maria Fries - 24th Ward
  - Mathius Kammer - 2 May 1853 - probably res. Green Twp
  - Agnes Kammer - date of death unknown - after 1850
  - Jacob Kammer (son of Mathius)
  - Mathius Kammer (son of Mathius)
