Today is Tuesday and the beautiful feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe. Last night we received word from Notre Dame Academy (across the blacktop from us) that they were having a Spanish Mass in honor of Our Lady of Guadalupe at 7:30 p.m. in their chapel. A priest from Columbia and an hispanic guitar group will be there. So I feel doubly blessed that on our Lady's special feastday I have the privilege of attending our own 5 p.m. Mass and the Spanish Mass too. I will take all of you along with me as well as all the petitions I have in Our Lady's pocket (this is where I put all the requests for prayers we sisters receive along with my own special intentions for all of you.)

The sun is shiny and bright right now and I just know the hall where the picture of Our Lady of Guadalupe is hanging (the picture that my sister Teresa painted for us) will be dazzling with sunshine when we go to chapel for Mass. It seems to happen every year.

I can hardly believe that another whole year has gone by since last Christmas. I hope you are all well and happy and rejoicing in the Lord. I wish a very Happy Advent to each of you as we await the birthday of our Baby Jesus. I think the anticipation of Christmas is almost as beautiful as the feast itself. We really have a lot of fun celebrating St. Nick's day each year. Seems like we are always celebrating something around here. Guess this is all part of the hundredfold that God promised us.

I'm just fine and filled with the peace and joy that knowing and loving God can give. Although I seldom get to see many of you I just want you to know how very much I love each of you and pray that your love for God increases day by day. I pray also that your love for the Mass, the sacrament of reconciliation; and your love for your family members grow more and more each day making this the happiest and most joyful new year you have ever had, overflowing with God's special graces and blessings.
