"Last Will and Testament of Mathias Kammer"

This document was written on June 16, 1855 - Mathias died on May 2, 1858

The original will was destroyed in the courthouse fire of 1884

He was our 3x Great Grandfather

Mathias Kammer Deceased.

It appearing to the Court that on the 25th day of June A. D. 1858 the Will and Testament of Mathias Kammer deceased was duly admitted Probate and Record in the Probate Court of Hamilton County Ohio, and the original Record of said Will and Probate thereof upon the Record Journal of said Court were destroyed in the burning of the Court on March 29th A. D. 1884, but that the original Will and the Petition

of the witnesses thereto were preserved; it is now ordered by the Court on its own motion that the Record of said Will and the Probate thereof be and the same is hereby restored from said original Will and Testimony as provided by Statute in the words and figures following to wit: "Was at the Court House in Cincinnati in the County of Hamilton and State of Ohio of the Hamilton Probate Court, at a session thereof held at the place aforesaid on the 25th day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty eight before the Honorable Geo. Ho. Nelson, Solo Judge of said Court, No. State of Ohio Hamilton County ss. Probate Court, Be it remembered, that on the day and year aforesaid the Last Will and Testament of Mathias Kammer late of this County deceased, was this day duly presented to the Court for Probate and Record, clothed in the words and figures following to wit: In the name of God Amen, I Mathias Kammer residing in Leipsic Township Hamilton County Ohio, do hereby make and publish this my last will, 1st I desire that all my just debts be paid out of my personal property, and that my body be decently interred according to the rites of the Catholic Church; 2. I give and devise to my beloved wife Agnes during her natural life all the income use and profit of my real estate whatsoever it may be or to which I may be in any way entitled at the time of my death, 3rd I give and devise to my said wife Agnes all my moneys, credits and personal property out of which she may pay all debts, expenses, and use whatever she needs for her support without rendering an account, whatever may then be left if any there be, shall be equally divided with the realty after the death of my said wife among all our children, 4th I

nominate and appoint my said wife, executrix of this my last will, hereby revoke-
ing all former wills. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal at
Cincinnati this sixteenth of June 1858 Mathias Kammer (signed, sealed &c.)
acknowledged by said Mathias Kammer as his last Will, in our presence and sub-
scribed by us in his presence and in presence of each other at his request
J. B. Moorman, Otho H. Vossler, Jacob Kammer, Phenomena on the same
day Jacob Kammer, one of the subscribing witnesses of the last Will and Test-
ament of Mathias Kammer deceased, personally appeared in open Court, and was
duly sworn and examined according to law, touching the due execution of
said Will and his testimony thereon was reduced to writing and filed in manner
and form following to-wit: - The State of Ohio Hamilton County S.S. Hamilton
Probate Court: The date of the last Will of Mathias Kammer deceased, pre-
sented on the 15th day of June A.D. 1858, personally appeared in open Court
Jacob Kammer one of the subscribing witnesses of the last Will and Test-
ament of Mathias Kammer deceased, who being duly sworn according to
law to speak the truth, the whole truth, and nothing but the truth, in relation
to said Will, deposes and says that he together with J. B. Moorman, (who is
now deceased) and Otho H. Vossler (who has gone to Germany) were present at
the making of said Will, and at the request of the deceased, subscribed their
names to said Will as witnesses in the presence of the deceased and of
each other, that they saw the said Mathias Kammer deceased, sign and seal
said Will, and heard him acknowledge the same to be his last Will and
Testament; that the said Mathias Kammer was at the time of making
said Will, of legal age, and of sound mind and memory
and under no undue or unlawful restraint with aforesaid, Jacob Kammer,
known to and subscribed in open Court, this 15th day of June A.D.

Alcuin was a member of the Franciscan order. His given name was Martin E., born November 22, 1896 in Cincinnati, Ohio, son of Martin J. and Catherine Kammer. He was the third born of eight children. He entered the Franciscans in 1915 and was given the religious name "Alcuin." He was ordained at Oldenburg, Indiana, in 1923 and celebrated his first mass at St. Boniface Church on June 10, 1923. His assignments included: teacher of civics and American history at the old St. Francis Seminary on Bremen Strasse (Republic Street) in downtown Cincinnati. He was assistant pastor at Sacred Heart Parish, Peoria, IL, and then moved to Higginville, MO, as pastor of several small "mission" parishes in Corder, Odessa and Dover. In 1930 he was named pastor at St. Mary of the Angels Parish in New Orleans for 18 years. This lengthy period was followed by relatively brief assignments in Peoria and Minonk, IL; Hamilton, OH; Southfield, MI; East Bottoms (Kansas City), MO. His final two years were spent as chaplain to the Public Health Hospital in Carville, LA. Poor health brought him back to Cincinnati where he died on June 1, 1961 at the age of 64, after 45 years as a Friar. He is buried in the friars' section at St. Mary's Cemetery, St. Bernard, OH.
